

Kent Minerals & Waste Development Framework

Kent County Council is the planning authority for minerals and waste sites. Kent needs these sites for economic minerals including construction materials and facilities for dealing with all waste that is produced in Kent.

We asked landowners to propose sites that might be developed and used for mineral extraction or waste in the future, and were sent 96 proposals to consider. These are set out in our consultation documents, but we know not all of them will be suitable.

The views that people give us will be taken into consideration as we compare the sites to decide which ones should go into final development plan documents and which should not.
