**1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN**

**4. RECIEPTS AND PAYMENTS TO 31-3-10**

**a) Adopt accounts – Section one of Audit form**

After examination of the accounts and an explanation by the Clerk it was proposed by Cllr Bury and seconded by Cllr Shevde that the accounts be adopted by the committee, all agreed. See Appendix A

**b) Agree Statement of assurances audit form**

**5. REVISED BUDGET FOR 2010/11**

The Councils carry forward it £19,332 higher than anticipated. This is made up of £4561 additional income (£2268 burials, £1322 VAT, £710 income from allotments and Parish Rm and £261 other income)

Spending was £14,754 less than predicted.

(£1122) admin (€594 insurance costs, €300 Cllr Training and Expenses, €80 web-site, €71 clerk's salary and €77 other).

(€2849) Ground Work (Tree and hedge work not necessary)

(€1014) Allotments and Leisure (Maintenance and repairs budget not spent)

(€284) Grant's (mainly coffee break allowance)

(€6310) Highways (€6000 traffic calming not spent)

(€2727) Contingency/other projects

(€982) Parade Lighting

(€130) Membership

(€15) Toilets

€175 Grave Digging Higher

€432 VAT Higher

€72 Parish room over spent
