A256 EASTRY BYPASS, EASTRY
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow essential carriageway strengthening and resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on A256 Eastry Bypass, Eastry, near Sandwich.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 21 January 2019 for up to 7 consecutive nights, from 21:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours each night.

A256 Eastry Bypass will be closed in both directions from the Dover Road / Cater Road roundabout northwards to the junction with Sandwich Bypass / A258 Deal Road.

~ There will be no direct access between Dover and Sandwich during these works ~

The alternative route for through traffic is via A256 Whitfield Bypass, A2 **Dover Road, Duke of York's Roundabout, A258** Deal Road, Dover Road, The Strand, Victoria Road, Ranelagh Road, (Deal Castle Road in opposite direction), Prince Of Wales Terrace, Beach Street, Broad Street, Queen Street, London Road, Sandwich Road, Deal Road and A256 Sandwich Road back to Eastry Bypass.

The following roads will be closed at their junctions with Eastry Bypass, with access to the remainder of each road continuing from their alternative junctions

- Northbourne Road, Betteshanger
- Sandwich Road, Eastry
- Felderland Lane, Worth

These works are part of an extensive resurfacing programme which is subject to weather and other factors that may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates, and any changes will be publicised.
