

BECOME A SNOW WARDEN

Snow wardens are volunteers from the local community who give up their spare time to help clear snow during bad weather.

Snow wardens will:

- Clear snow from footpaths
- Spread and lay grit/salt to stop ice from forming

You will need to be physically fit and have basic equipment such as high visibility clothing, gloves and non-slip footwear, e.g. waterproof boots/wellingtons. Other equipment such as shovels and grit/salt can be provided if required.
