2. PLANNING APPLICATION

a) Applications

i. DOV/09/00483

Proposal: Creation of car parking spaces and alterations to existing parking area
Location: Amenity Lane, Orchard Road, Eastry

After examination of the plans and some discussion it was agreed that no objections should be made to this application.

ii. DOV/09/00444

Proposal: Erection of fence, wall and the installation of electric gates
Location: Little Statenborough House, Sandwich Road, Eastry

After examined of the plans and a lengthy discussion it was agreed that the Council would object to this application of the following grounds:-

- The style and design of the gates will detract from the listed building
- The height and length of the proposed fence will change the look of the area and be an intrusion on the landscape.

iii. TC/09/00042/TC

Proposal: Removal of one Hazel and one Ash and self –sown Sycamore, Ash and Hazel Saplings, crown raise Yew and Thorn tree, plus various garden maintenance works
Location: Brook House, Brook Street, Eastry, Sandwich
